Kindergarten Orientation: Friday, August 18 at 9:00-9:45 a.m. in your child's homeroom. Mrs. Grossman and Mrs. Morgan will present a brief overview of curriculum, schedule and expectations. Students may bring their supplies at this time.

<u>Meet Your Teacher</u>: Friday, August 18 (9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.) Parents may bring their children to school to meet their teachers, see their classrooms and bring in their supplies. Students may visit classrooms anytime during this time. No presentation will be given.
