



Homeroom Lists: Homeroom assignments will be emailed and posted on the windows by the office on Thursday, August 12, 2021 after 3:00 pm.

Kindergarten Orientation: Friday, August 20 at 9:00-10:00 a.m. in your child's homeroom. Mrs. Morgan will present a brief overview of curriculum, schedule and expectations. Students may bring their supplies at this time.

Meet Your Teacher: Friday, August 20 (9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.) Parents may bring their children to school to meet their teachers, see their classrooms and bring in their supplies. Students may visit classrooms anytime during this time. No presentation will be given.

Morning Arrival: We will begin each day with prayer at **7:50 am** so I ask that all students be in their classroom by **7:50**. **Students who arrive after 7:50 am will be considered tardy.** Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Students in grade 4-8 who are tardy will receive a tardy slip. After receiving 3 tardy slips the student must serve an after school detention and after 5 they must serve 2 detentions.

Dismissal Procedures: The students will be dismissed at 2:40 pm in the following order: 1) Bus Riders, 2) Car Riders, 3) Walkers. Car riders will be dismissed from the gym door, which faces Route 224. All car riders will report to the school gym for dismissal. *Please enter through the west driveway and form a line to pick up your child and exit through the church driveway.*

Please watch for children excitedly hurrying to and from the building and remember to follow the speed limit in order to keep our children safe.

Annual Flag Raising Ceremony: August 23 at **8:00 am**. If the weather does not cooperate, children may report directly to the gym.

Lunches will be served beginning the first day of school. **School lunches will be FREE to all students for the 2021-2022 school year.** A full lunch must be ordered to purchase an extra slice of pizza on Cocco's pizza day. Extra slices of pizza must be paid for by Wednesday of that week. The children will receive a special ticket in the morning on pizza day to give to the cashier when coming down to lunch.

Please note that the guidelines for milk allergies have been changed. The Ohio Department of Education Office of Safety, Health and Nutrition states that the only substitute for regular milk that can be counted as reimbursable meals is lactose free milk product.
